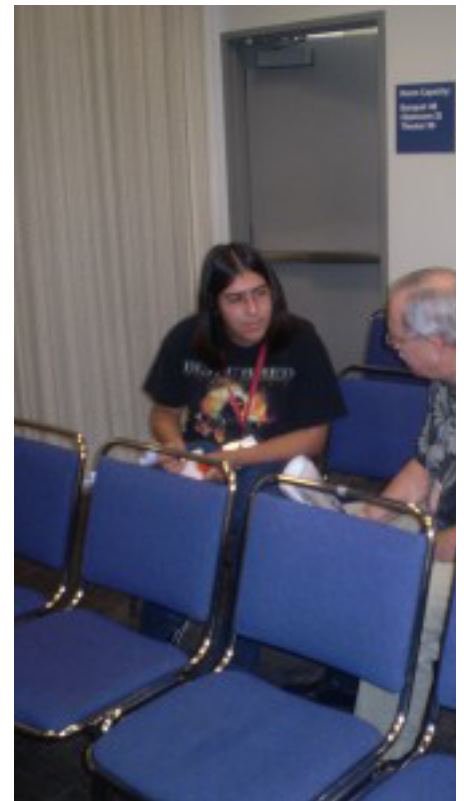
"Chillin in Sactown"
